The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) comes into force on 25th May 2018 and will replace the current Data Protection Act governing how personal data is processed.

The GDPR was developed to create a more up to date law for data protection reflecting the changes in the digital age and strengthening the rights of individuals and how their personal data is processed and protected. Many of the GDPR's main concepts and principles are much the same as those in the Data Protection Act but with new elements and enhancements and a greater emphasis on accountability and how organisations demonstrate their compliance.

Our plans for Compliance

The Little Group is committed to the security and the protection of all personal data in line with legal requirements and best practice at all times. We are in the process of planning and executing those changes necessary to be fully compliant in advance of 25th May 2018 and will make any necessary adjustments to these plans as further guidance continues to emerge from data protection authorities.

We will publish an update to this statement as and when necessary on the progress towards ensuring The Little Group is compliant prior to the new rules coming into force on 25 May 2018.
